

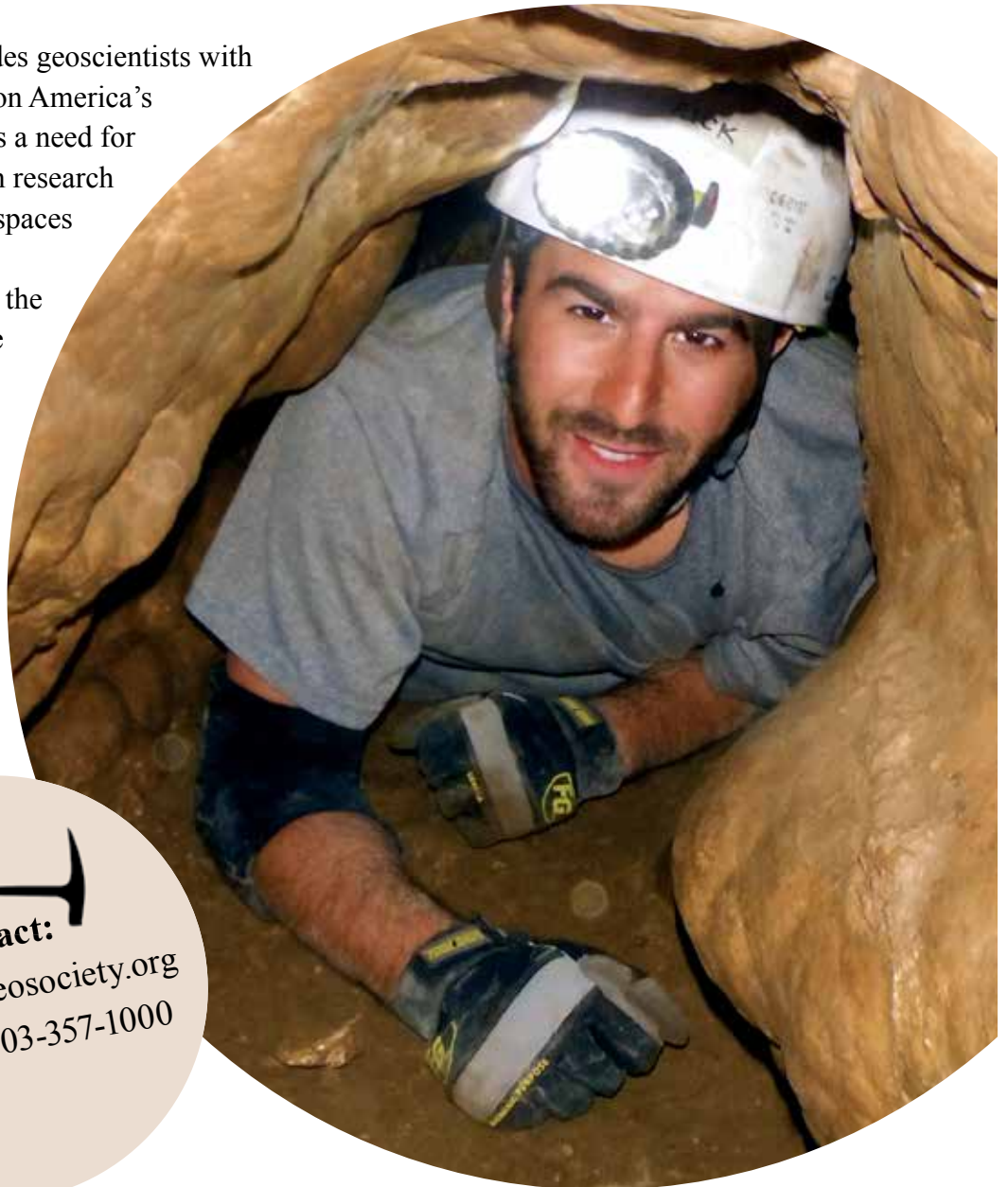


Geoscientists Working for Education, Conservation, and Research on America's Public Lands
